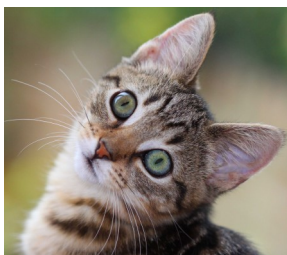

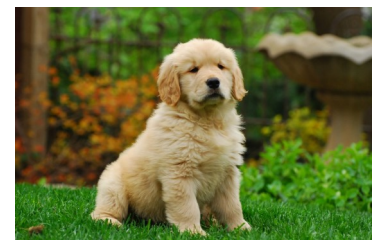
You can drop off your donations to
